## Y2 Home reading

There are two types of reading book that children in Y2 take home with them - a reading practice book and a sharing book.

## A reading practice book:

There are two types of reading practice books:

1. Phonetically decodable books — for children on our Little Wandle phonics programme. These phonetically decodable books are levelled at the correct phonic stage for your child. Your child should be able to read this fluently and independently/with minimal help. If your child cannot read a word, we advise parents to simply read it to them. Please also talk to your child about the book/story.

2. **Natural language banded books** – for those children reading at Purple level and above who have completed our phonics programme.

Books are changed **twice a week**, so as to give time for children to re-read/re-visit the book 2-3 times before swapping it for a new one. This is in line with how we read books in school.

## A sharing book:

This book is for parent and child to read and enjoy together. The sharing book is chosen by the child from the class book corner. This happens once a week on a Thursday. Children are not expected to read it themselves. Please read it to or with your child, discussing the pictures, predicting what might happen next, using different voices for the characters etc.

## Books are sent home using the following system:
