

Pendarren House (8th June to 12th June) Kit List

Important

- Bed linen: single duvet cover, single sheet and one pillow case (duvet and pillow are provided by Pendarren House)
- Water bottle – ideally a large bottle, such as a 750ml or 1 litre
- Up to date medication for travel sickness/asthma/hay-fever/epi-pens etc – more details to be given soon.
- School uniform – children will wear this on the outward and return journeys.

Clothing and shoes

- Warm tops, sweatshirts or jumpers x 3 (e.g. fleece sweaters)
- Shirts or T-shirts x 5 (some with long sleeves)
- Trousers x 4 for activities (jogging bottoms or leggings, **not jeans** as they are not as easy to move around in)
- At least one casual outfit for evenings and relaxation (jeans are allowed for this)
- Underwear (enough for the week, plus a couple extra)
- Trainers x 1 pair (old ones, for activities)
- Trainers x 1 pair (for inside wear)
- Towel x 1 (for activities; optionally bring an extra one, just in case)
- Swimming costume (just in case)
- Nightwear / pyjamas
- Dressing gown and slippers (optional)
- Thick socks x 3 pairs, plus thinner socks (enough for the week)
- Wellington boots (if already owned). Can be borrowed from the Centre for no charge.
- Walking boots (if already owned). Can be borrowed from the Centre for no charge.
- Sunscreen and peaked sunhats for warm weather and sun
- A “dress to impress” outfit for a fun evening!

Other

- Tissues/toilet roll (especially if suffering from a cold or hay fever)
- Books/magazines/puzzles for the journey, and to read before bed
- Plastic bags for wet clothes – plus extra newspapers to put inside wet shoes
- Spending money – max of £20 (in change) in an envelope **clearly labelled** with the child’s name
- Stamped and addressed envelope (with home address on it)
- Wash Bag to include: soap, flannel/sponge, deodorant, toothbrush and tooth paste, shampoo, hairbrush/comb and shower gel
- Optional: eye masks and earplugs may be useful to help your child fall sleep

Please note: old clothes (that you are happy to get dirty) are most suitable for activities at Pendarren House

We encourage you not to buy anything new if possible, particularly as Pendarren have resources to borrow.

Please note:

Anything the children bring with them will be their responsibility – the school cannot take responsibility for anything lost – this includes money!

Things not to bring:

- Chewing gum (for the same reasons it is not allowed in school!)
- Anything you do not want to lose or damage: e.g., jewellery
- Electronic items such as kindles, smart watches/sports watches, phones, cameras.
- **No mobile phones/electronic devices, such as airtags are allowed.** You will be contacted immediately in case of emergency.

Note that Pendarren is equipped to provide waterproof jacket, trousers, walking boots, wellington boots, wetsuits and other specialist protective clothing as well as rucksacks.
